

A. Reading Roman Numerals

Individual Values:

I = 1 V = 5 X = 10 L = 50 C = 100 D = 500 M = 1,000

Two or three, all the same value - simply add:

II (I+I)= III(I+I+i)= XX(X+X)=

XXX= CC= CCC= MM=

Two of different values - add if the largest value comes first:

VI(V+I)= XV(X+V)= XI(X+I)=

LX= LV= CX= MC= DL=

Two of different values - subtract if the smallest value comes first:

IX(X-I)= XL(L-X)= CD(D-C)=

XC= CM= IV=
